

COOKIE POLICY

1. Data Controller

2. Purposes of Using Cookies

Cookies are used for the following purposes:

- **Ensuring website functionality:** Necessary cookies (e.g., session cookies).
- **Traffic analysis:** Analytical cookies (e.g., Google Analytics – statistical purposes).

3. Types of Cookies

- **Necessary (session / first-party):** Essential for logging in and security; do not require user consent.
- **Analytical (persistent / third-party):** Used to monitor website statistics; require prior user consent.

4. Retention Period and Recipients

- **Session cookies:** Stored until the web browser is closed.
- **Analytical cookies:** Stored for 13 to 25 months (e.g., Google Analytics: 14 months; recipient: Google Ireland Ltd.).

5. Expressing and Withdrawing Consent

Consent for non-essential cookies is voluntary (opt-in). You can manage your preferences via the website's cookie banner or browser settings (e.g., Chrome: Settings > Privacy and Security > Cookies). Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent prior to its withdrawal.

6. User Rights

Users have the right to access, rectify, and erase their personal data pursuant to Articles 15–17 of the GDPR. Please contact us to exercise these rights.
